Domestic Violence Project

- Pro bono attorneys represent survivors of abuse and stalking in contested restraining order hearings.
- Cases have short timelines, limited issues, & a court appearance.
- Excellent pro bono opportunity for attorneys seeking courtroom experience.
- Volunteers are not expected to assist clients with ongoing family law cases.
- Attorneys sign up in advance to be available to take a case on call or on a certain day.
- Online CLE's, mentorship and extensive materials available.

Housing Notice Clinic



Housing Notice Clinic

- Volunteer Attorneys review tenants' notice of termination to determine whether notice is valid.
- Attorneys advise tenants on validity of the notice, draft demand letters and negotiate settlements when defenses are present.
- Opportunities for continued assistance available.
- Attorneys sign up to receive case referrals via email.
- Online CLE and extensive materials available.
- Excellent opportunity for new attorneys.
- Virtual volunteer opportunity.

Expungement Clinics



Expungement Clinics

- Volunteer attorney reviews client records to assess eligibility for expungement.
- Attorneys complete all necessary paperwork for court when client is eligible.
- Great opportunity for new attorneys and attorneys who cannot commit to long term cases.
- Training and resources available.
- Virtual and In-person volunteer opportunity.
- Attorneys sign up for referral list.






Modest Means Program

- Reduced hourly rates of \$60, \$80 or \$100 per hour based on client income and assets as measured against the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Family Law, Criminal Defense, Landlord/Tenant.
- 30,000 calls per year with approximately 4,000 referrals made.




Pro Bono Programs

- Military Assistance Panel
 - 2 hours of pro bono work for active duty military and families
- Problem Solvers
 - Free 30-minute consultations for children aged 13-17
- FEMA
- COVID-19

Lawyer Referral Service (LRS)

- Approximately 500 attorney panelists (September 2021)
- Statewide, all areas of law
- Promoted through oregonstatebar.org, summons form, legal system stakeholders, craigslist, Google
- Over 50,000 referrals per year
- 85,000 Calls, 7,000 online referral requests (OLR)





LRS Registration Fees

- Basic Registration:
 - 1-3 yrs = \$50
 - > 3 yrs = \$100
- Additional Panels: \$30 each
- Each additional territory costs \$50. A statewide registration costs \$300.

LRS Percentage Fees

- Monthly Reporting through OSB website.
- 12% remittance on each LRS-referred matter in which the panelist *earns and collects* attorneys' fees.
- The \$35 initial consultation fee, if charged, is not subject to any remittance.
- LRS has generated over \$35 million for panelist attorneys since October of 2012.

How Percentage Fees Work

Percentage	12%
Case No. 1 (\$500 in fees) Remittance to LRS	\$60
Case No. 2 (\$5,000 in fees) Remittance to LRS	\$600

- best way to increase access is to create more legal aid staff attorney positions.
- client funds. The funds are paid to the Oregon State Bar for appropriation to legal aid through the Oregon State Bar's Legal Services Program.
- Shop. Support legal aid when you shop at Fred Meyer by linking your rewards card to CEJ (www.fredmeyer.com) and when you shop at Amazon through Smile.Amazon.Com. It costs you nothing, but supports legal aid.
- You nothing, dut supports regarding.

 Educate, Talk about the importance of access to justice. Let people know—civil legal aid is there for those who need help. Host a Campaign for Equal Justice CLE for one hour of Access to Justice credit for attorneys.
- Endow. Take simple steps to endow your annual gift to the Campaign's endowment fund.
- Volunteer through one of legal aid's many volunteer lawyer projects and clinics, or help the Campaign for Equal Justice raise money for legal aid.
- Speak Up. Let state, federal and private funders know that access to justice is important.
- Learn how legal aid services are delivered in your community so that you can make appropriate referrals for low-income clients.
- institution that is an Oregon Law Foundation Leadership Bank or Credit Union. If all lawyers took this step, funding for legal aid could increase by as much as \$1.7 million— enough to fund two small rural legal aid offices. Contact the OLF at www.oregonlawfoundation.org.
